

Star Tree Toppper

designed by Rosemarie Walter

Materials needed:

- Kreinik 1/8" Ribbon in 202HL Aztec Gold, 53 yards
- Kreinik Japan #1 002J Gold for attaching beads
- 10-count plastic canvas
- 8" x 4" piece of blue velvet
- Gold bugle beads: large, medium and small, also gold seed beads

Instructions:

- 1. Cut two stars from 10-count plastic canvas. Do not cut out shaded areas yet.
- 2. Fill sink with warm water. Immerse stars to soften for about 30

seconds. Take out and fold plastic canvas on lines 1 through 4 (as shown in diagram top left), re-softening as needed. Turn over and fold other lines from the back.

- 3. Cut out shaded areas on both pieces (front and back of the star).
- 4. Stitch ornament with 1/8" Ribbon 202HL Aztez Gold Hi Lustre (gold lines, shown partially graphed). Overcast edges in cut-out areas. Whipstitch lower star edges from star marks to bottom tip.
- 5. Thread needle with Japan thread and couch medium bugle beads, working from center out. Sew remaining beads in place.
 - 6. Sew velvet behind cut-out areas.
- 7. Whipstitch two stars together above marks. This leaves the bottom finished and open to slide onto the top of your Christmas tree.

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
